CRRSA Act (HEERF II) Report & Disclosure as of June 30, 2021

Iowa State University acknowledges it signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement on April 15, 2020, giving the assurance that Iowa State University intended to use no less than 50% of the funds received under section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students. On December 27, 2020, the President signed the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) (P.L. 116-260). The CRRSAA requires that an institution receiving funding under section 314(a)(1) provide the “same amount” in financial aid grants to students from the new CRRSAA funds that it was required or which it would have been required to provide under its original CARES Act Student Aid Portion award.

1. The total amount of funds Iowa State University received from the U.S. Department of Education for distribution to students under section 314(a)(1) of the CRRSA Act is **\$10,849,429**. Initial funds were drawn on April 29, 2021.
2. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under section 314(a)(1) of the CRRSA Act as of June 30, 2021, is **\$10,849,429**.
3. The total number of students who received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under section 314(a)(1) of the CRRSA Act is **7,319**.
4. All students receiving Emergency Financial Aid Grants under section 314(a)(1) of the CRRSA Act must meet these criteria:
 - Undergraduate or graduate/professional student enrolled during 2020-2021
 - Eligible for funding under Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965
 - Demonstrate exceptional need

Block awards provided as follows:

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

EFC = 0-5711: Students awarded \$1,600. Total number of students awarded = 4,861

EFC = 5712-10711: Students awarded \$1,300. Total number of students awarded = 1,971

GRADUATE/PROFESSIONAL STUDENTS

All FAFSA filers who indicated children in the household were awarded \$1,600/ Total number of students awarded = 178

REMAINING FUNDS

E-mails were sent to the entire campus community inviting applications.

Of the 979 applications received, 309 students were awarded amounts from \$254 - \$1,300 depending on the nature of their need.

Instructions were not provided for the block grants. A communication was sent to students using their ISU email address, notifying them in regard to the application process. Additionally, the same message was posted in CANVAS, Iowa State University's Learning Management System, so all students had access to see.

Funds are fully spent. This is the institution's final quarterly posting and it covers all remaining HEERF fund expenditures for the HEERF II student portion of funds. No more quarterly public reporting of Student Portion funds is required. This should be our first and final quarterly report.
